



## Germany: 34-day tax tolerance threshold soon !

### Surprise !

Belgian, French and German residents will soon all benefit from the same number of days for their tax tolerance threshold. So no more muddling through the different thresholds ...

On 6 th July, Germany and Luxembourg signed an amendment to their Double Taxation Treaty **raising the tax tolerance threshold from 19 to 34 days, as of 2024.**

As a result, each country must now transpose this amendment into its domestic law in order to make this good news effectively applicable.

Once transposed, all frontier workers will benefit from a 34-day tax tolerance threshold as of 2024.

As a reminder, the tax tolerance threshold covers teleworking, training abroad, client meetings, business travel ... In short, all days worked outside Luxembourg territory !

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
